Established in 2007 to honor SMAD Professors Alan Neckowitz and Charles Turner, who were instrumental in founding the Ireland in Text & Image summer program, the Neckowitz/Turner Study Abroad Scholarship is awarded to a SMAD major participating in a JMU study abroad program. The \$500 award is based on academic achievement and financial need. First priority would be students in the JMU Ireland in Text & Image summer program. Students are eligible to apply after official admittance into a JMU Study Abroad Program.

Applicants are expected to have a minimum 2.75 overall grade point average. The selection committee may interview finalists for the awards.
